



Webinar on Dry Bulk Management Standard



ALPHA MARINE CONSULTING MARITIME TRAINING CENTER will conduct a Webinar on Dry Bulk Management Standard (DBMS) on the 1st of July 2020.

The DBMS is designed to allow ship managers of Bulk Carriers to assess the efficiency of their own Safety Management System (SMS) against the proposed industry standards and expectations, with an aim of improving Company's performance and risk management. This aims to ensure that the operators' policies align with the industry best practices to both advance their performance and to attain high HSQE standards. The DBMS presently consists of a draft self-assessment questionnaire that is open for review in order to gather feedback from the industry.

Rightship aims to launch the Standard early in 2021 and to incorporate a dashboard that will show how a company's self-assessment compares to other companies on a range of statistics that have been identified as indicators of good management.

The objective of this Seminar is to take a dive into the DBMS, which covers **30 Subject Areas** of ship management, within 4 sections – **Performance, People, Plant and Processes**. Participants will be guided through the established levels of expected compliance, key points requiring special attention and KPIs. Furthermore, they will have the chance to assess their Company's policies, practices and procedures against the newly introduced requirements.

Both shore and ship based personnel of shipping companies dealing with Bulk Carriers as Managers, Marine and Technical Superintendents, DPAs, as well as ships' Masters, Chief Engineers and Chief Officers.
